



5 DAYS TANZANIA ROAD SAFARI

Day 1: Arrival Arusha

Pick up from Kilimanjaro or Arusha Airport, after clearing with immigration meet your professional driver guide and transfer to your hotel

Overnight at **Kahawa House based on Bed and breakfast**

Day 2: Arusha - Tarangire National Park

Breakfast at the hotel, collect lunch boxes and drive out to Tarangire National Park for game drive,

Proceed with game drive later drive out to the camp for dinner and overnight,

Overnight: **Maramboi Tented Lodge based on Full Board**

Tarangire National Park, situated within Tanzania's spectacular Manyara Region, is an awe-inspiring national park comprising of granite ridges, river valleys, mixed vegetative landscapes, and free-roaming wildlife. Home of Elephant and Baobab trees, not only that but also the river that save a thousand of animals during the dry season including wildebeest, zebra, lions, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest, eland, dry-country antelope such as oryx and gerenuk.

Day 3: Manyara National Park

Early morning walk at lake Manyara shore followed with breakfast,

Depart with lunch boxes and drive to lake Manyara for game viewing, late afternoon drive to Karatu

Rest of the day spend at leisure,

Overnight at **Pamoja Farm Lodge based on Full Board**

Located on the way to Ngorongoro Crater and the Serengeti, Lake Manyara National Park is worth a stop in its own right. Its ground water forests, bush plains, baobab strewn cliffs, tree-climbing lions and algae-streaked hot springs offer incredible ecological variety in a small area, rich in wildlife and incredible numbers of birds.

Day 4: Crater Ngorongoro

In the morning depart with picnic-lunch to Ngorongoro Crater for Game Drives.

Descent into the Crater floor for full day game viewing, later after drive back to the lodge

Overnight at **Pamoja Farm Lodge based on Full Board**



The Ngorongoro Crater is one of Africa's most famous sites and is said to have the highest density of wildlife in Africa, sometimes described as an 'eighth wonder of the world'. The crater floor consists of a number of different habitats that include grassland, swamps, forests and Lake Makat (Maasai for 'salt'). Ngorongoro Crater is one of the most likely areas in Tanzania to see the endangered Black Rhino, as a small population is thriving in this idyllic and protected environment.

Day 5: Departure day – Drive out

After breakfast drive back to Arusha, lunch at one of the restaurants at Arusha town, after lunch transfer to the either Kilimanjaro Airport or Arusha Airport for onward flight (*if times allows a complimentary city tour in Arusha town before transfer to the airport for onward flight*).
